Cast aside the weight of national and global uncertainties and step into God's rhythm of joy. In this divine exchange, God swaps out the old for the new and infuses the new with purpose. Your mourning transcends happiness into dancing, becoming a visible, infectious expression of joy that affects everything around you.

To fully step into this, we must start by exchanging our earthly perspectives for God's viewpoint. If we continue to approach life from the mindset of what we have or don't have in natural terms, we will consistently be limited by it. There is a better way, and a greater assurance, one guaranteed by the efficacy of the cross. Don't take your bearings from what the situation is telling you or from what you lack to give back in exchange, take your bearings from what God has said concerning you - You have taken off my sackcloth and clothed me with joy, that my soul may sing praise to You and not be silent. Are you silent? Don't be! Leap for joy as Zaccheaus did when he threw off his garment of shame and ran toward Jesus. Let us trade our limited resources for God's abundant provision, our human strategies for divine wisdom. In doing so, we position ourselves not just to overcome challenges but to emerge with testimonies that defy human explanation.
